On the 2nd of April we started our first SPACE Programme for 2025. We had nine brand new mums and bubs join us for the 30 week support/educational group. They were all so excited to be at the first meeting and there was an air of anticipation as they started to build relationships with Louise (Facilitator), Lauralyn (Facilitator's Assistant) and the other mums in the group.

The Coffee Group is going exceptionally well, every week someone new is attending. It's a great time for the mums to bond over shared experiences, whether it's navigating the early stages of motherhood or chatting about the joys and challenges of raising little ones. The centre's relaxed environment and warm atmosphere allows for informal conversations, fostering new friendships and offering emotional support. Babies enjoy interacting with one another, and the group has quickly become a positive social hub where mums can exchange tips, share advice, and simply take a moment to relax (the massages help greatly with this too). We are thrilled to have two new and wonderful bakers helping with the delicious morning teas as well. The Liberty Project © is a small Christian faith based, non-profit organisation located in Nacala, Northern Mozambique.

Our heart is to see young women liberated from abuse, exploitation and cultural oppression. We work to empower each woman through discipleship, education, skills training and employment in social enterprise.

It's estimated that around 98% of Mozambican females have been sexually abused; whether it be from cultural ceremony, sexual exploitation or through the 'norms' of womanhood that culture perpetrates.

Update from Laura

Dear Friends

March has been a mixed bag for us! Many ups and downs with Cyclone Jude hitting us on the 10th March. Esther, Paulo and I were in Pemba making cyclone repairs on my home when more severe flooding meant that we were unable to take the same route home - so instead of a 403 km journey it was a 1700 km-five-day journey! On the bright side - the scenery was utterly stunning! We were so thankful for no mechanical issues or problems with police along the way. In fact, it turned out to be a blessed time together as a team. Thank you for praying us through this!



We are grateful for the extra financial support we have received, which has enabled us to assist Paulo, Alupai, Maria, Anita, and Anchura in repairing their homes. They all had at least one external wall in their homes collapse from the cyclone which left them completely vulnerable and open to the elements.

The Liberty Centre experienced damage as well, but we've been able to repair the broken tent and waterproofing is underway. We have also been scrubbing the black mould off our walls and repainting six of the rooms.

Since my return, I have not only been overseeing the repairs but also continued with the Hospitality training. The girls have been focusing on cakes and desserts; Pannacotta, Crème Brûlée, Lemon Meringue Pie, Raspberry White Chocolate Shortcake, and Apple Crumble just to name a few. The girls have found it challenging to learn new things, but we've all been enjoying the taste testing at the end of each lesson!



We are now entering the last six week of our Vocational Training Programs. Please continue to pray for the girls so they can start putting what they have learned into practice. We are now heading down the final straight and are feeling the pressure – please also pray for the teachers, it's a demanding time for them.

A big prayer point! Our Wega Coffee Machine has been out of action since last September and we have been problem-solving and replacing parts – we've spent hours and hours trying to fix it to no avail. We really do ask for your prayers that the problem will be found so we can resolve it in the next two weeks. We are two months behind in starting our barista training and we can't open the Café without a coffee machine! ☹️

The Café container conversion is underway. Praise the Lord! We have just finished the cutting and re-welding of the container and will now start the fit-out by putting in a new floor, ceiling and walls. We will put a division between the service and storage area too. Once that is done, we will install the water and electrics, then do the carpentry, painting, etc. Please continue to pray for provision for this and the other phases in the cafe project still to come. Time is getting short now. The opening of the Café is scheduled for the 31st May.

Below are areas we need sponsorship for the Café (in order of importance):

- Container walls, ceiling and carpentry \$1000 - immediate need.
- Wood purchase and furniture carpentry \$2000 - immediate need.
- Upholstery: couches & seating \$1500 – 10th April.
- Electrical: Lights, fans and electrical instillation, seating area and container interior \$1000 – 10th April.
- Plumbing install: Water to container, Washroom and basin \$350 – 1st May.
- Paint: \$1500 (rust primer, metal paint, and mural for container and surrounds, labour to employ local artist) – 1st May.
- Startup funds for the first six months for salaries for 11 girls, \$2000 per month beginning 1st June (\$12,000 total). If you're interested in sponsoring one of the women's monthly salaries, please let me know. These vary depending on the role, I can give you more information.
- Community Opening: Food & staff \$500 20th May.

We are thrilled to see small steps being made for the Cafe development - seating structure is complete. This is despite the challenges we've faced with the cyclone, then our LONG journey home and a small team doing full-time training in two subjects!

Next month we will have a couple of volunteers arriving to help us around the Centre – I am looking forward to the extra help. I am personally looking forward to the opening of the Café too as it will enable us to start training the girls and watching as they take on their new employment and having the business grow – it will be a new era for Liberty Nacala!

Pray that we glorify God in all our daily work, being an example of Jesus to them in ways we don't even realize.

Pray also that each one of our team would continue to have a personal experience with Jesus.
