The Liberty Project © is a small Christian faith based, non-profit organisation located in Nacala, Northern Mozambique.

Our heart is to see young women liberated from abuse, exploitation and cultural oppression. We work to empower each woman through discipleship, education, skills training and employment in social enterprise.

It's estimated that around 98% of Mozambican females have been sexually abused; whether it be from cultural ceremony, sexual exploitation or through the 'norms' of womanhood that culture perpetrates.

Laura Monahan is a missionary based in Nacala. Her role is founder and director of The Liberty Project - Based on Isaiah 61.

Update from Laura

Dear Friends

September has been a jam-packed month! Over the course of our first Beauty vocational training programme, four girls dedicated their lives to Jesus! We've seen Jesus do powerful things in this group! This month we had the privilege of baptising three of them (see photos bottom of page 3) - In the last week of the programme we all made the hike through the bush to the beach where we baptised Nazima, Malina and Amina! The girls boldly testified of what Jesus has done in their lives, one was just about to convert to Islam, and another just renounced Islam! THANK YOU, Jesus for growing your local church and bringing LIFE to this unreached people group!

It's official, we now have our first group of Beauty graduates! This is a new milestone for The Liberty Project – our whole team celebrated. Our first ever Beauty Vocational training group, consisted of eight precious women! They're now skilled in Nail Tech, Massage Therapy and Hairdressing. Please pray for this group as they now go out into the real world looking for work - employment here is scarce. Please also pray for us as we plan on employing two/three of the girls in the new year to open "Beauty by Liberty", our future Salon and Massage Studio. Pray for provision for this, to commit to hiring these girls in the start-up phase of this new business. The beauty industry has a much higher minimum wage in Mozambique compared to Hospitality or Informal Education (about \$NZ416 monthly).



On the Design Studio front, we are also celebrating as we have received our first official order! Ima, Maria and Neyma are busy in the artisan studio putting together the order for MAF, some of you might know of them, Mission Aviation Fellowship. We were contacted by them after they heard a good report about the quality of our products. They've made a good-sized order so they can stock our items in the USA gift shop to represent Mozambique, one of the territories in which they operate! We are so grateful and have thanked the Lord for this order. It is such an encouragement for us. We have been praying for stores and/or distributors to come on board to make this a viable business and give work to our artisan team. I'm working closely with the girls on design, textiles and quality control to ensure this order is excellent so we can gain repeat business from them. Pray for us as we are under a tight time constraint to complete by 13th October!



September saw the Café grow, THANK YOU JESUS! I've been working closely with the girls with customer service and in the kitchen to keep improving our service. Our pizzas are proving to be a real success, I thank the Lord for this, it was a last-minute decision to add pizza to our menu. This was a God idea as our pizza sales are sustaining our business.



We have begun an outdoor cinema night series with the second of three coming up. The first night only attracted a small group, but it was a success! This month we are showing the most recent Mission Impossible movie, as voted by our customers. Pray that we get a good turn out and that it is an income booster for us. We will need the extra income as the impending rainy season is coming, which might see a drop in patronage due to the condition of mud road to get to us and the unpredictable nature of the weather! We need all your prayer through the Christmas season for this!



On a personal note, it's been a faith stretching month for me as I've been believing for the finances necessary for some large personal needs. Both my Work Visa and Work Permit are due for renewal before the end of October at a total of \$NZ3790. The good news is \$NZ2887 has already come in, so I only need \$NZ903 now which is needed by the 25th October.

It's now time for me to take a trip to NZ, my last visit was at the end of 2020 during Covid! I'm really looking forward to coming home and reconnecting with you all, to see my family, friends and be among kiwi culture again. It's been five years since I've been home - this trip is well overdue. I am so thankful to share that my South Africa to New Zealand return flights have been purchased! Thank you to those who have given so far and who have prayed for provision. I now only need to book my Mozambique to South Africa return flight – I would like to do asap to prevent fare increases, at the moment the fare is \$NZ1200.

Please join me in praying for complete provision for these needs in the next two weeks. Pray for my time with the Cafe team before I leave, as I form a leadership team with three of the girls. They will be responsible for managing the cafe in the three months that I will be away and they will need wisdom, integrity, leadership, responsibility and godliness.

If you feel to give towards my flights or Visa costs, please do so through New Day Church with the reference Laura Trip. I am very grateful for every amount given. Thank you for being part of this work with me!

Please also be praying for our national registration of The Liberty Project, the approval of this is necessary for us to provide work visas to missionaries like Becca, who is still waiting (I was told it could take anywhere between one month and a year several months ago), so you can see our need for prayer! We are needing Becca back on the ground in February to lead her department and teach in our Freedom Program.

Thank you everybody for continuing to pray for our work here in Mozambique! We've seen the Lord do some wonderful things in the last month and are expectant of great things as we finish up orders, and activities and close our ministry in December.
